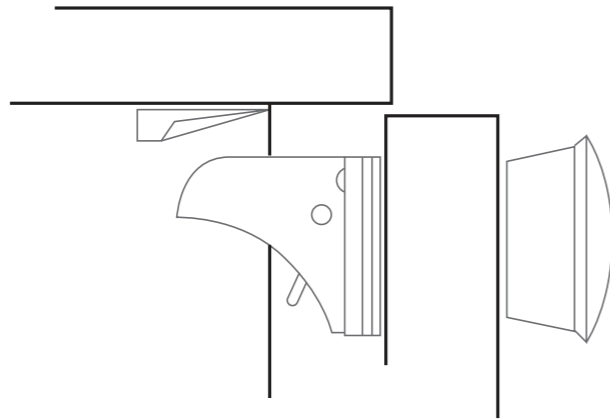


Child Proof Magnetic Cabinet Locks (4 Pack)

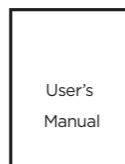

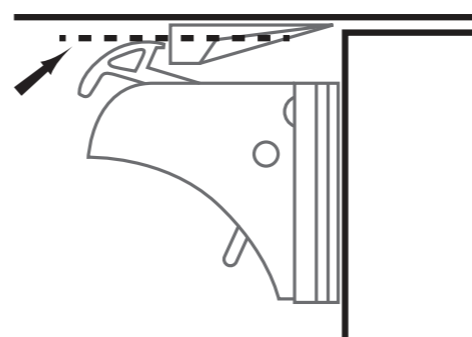
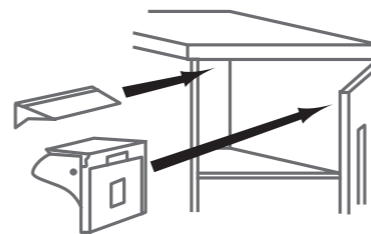
Specifications

- Material: ABS, Magnetic
- Magnetic force: up to 1.25" thick
- Adhesive: 3M (1mm thick)
- Lock size (LxWxH): 1.50" x 1.25" x 1.75"
- Latch size (LxWxH): 1.5" x 1.75" x 0.25"
- Key size (LxWxH): 1.44" x 1.44" x .75"
- Net/Gross Weight: 0.20lb / 0.27lb

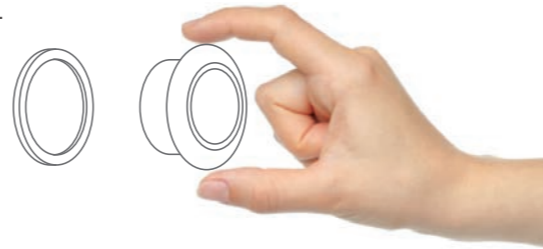
Setup

1. Align the lock & latch to the inside of your cabinet door and frame, then remove the adhesive film and adhere them.

Note: Please allow the adhesive to adhere for 30 min before applying maximum strength to try and open your cabinet when locked.

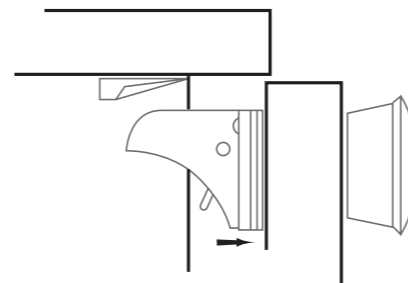


2. Find a high area (out of reach from children) and adhere the metal key cap which is used to hold the magnetic key when not in use.

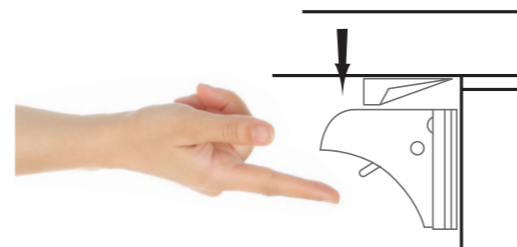


Unlocking the latch

To unlock the latch, simply place the magnetic key on the outside of the cabinet where the latch is placed and pull the door open.



You may also disable the child lock latch by simply moving the manual unlock lever forward at anytime. This will allow the cabinet to open and close freely until the lever is moved back into normal locking mode.
