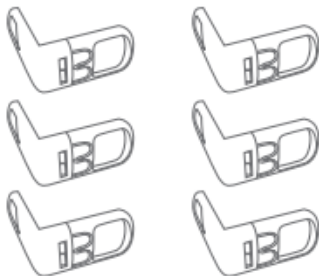


Child proofing drawer and Cabinet Safety Locks (6 Pack)

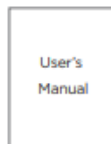

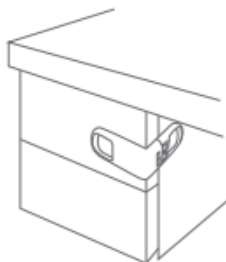
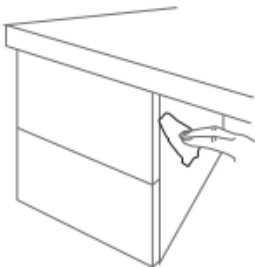
Specifications

- Material: Recycle ABS (Plastic)
- Lock: Close drawer to lock
- Unlock: Press both button to unlock
- Adhesive: 3M PE foam
- Dimension (LxWxH): 3.0" x 3.0" x .25"
- Weight (GW/NW): 0.44lb / 0.28lb

Setup

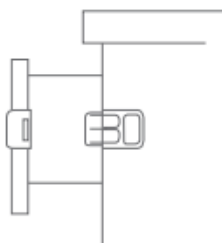
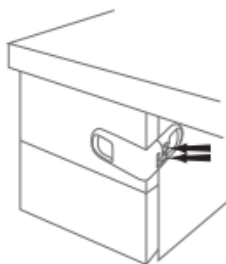
Clean and dry the surface where the DRAWERLOCK will be placed, then peel off the 3M protective film and "gently" press the CORNERSTOP into place. Before applying full pressure give the CORNERSTOP a test by opening (by pressing the two release buttons) and closing the drawer/cabinet to make sure the lock fully locks into place when closed. Then press/hold the adhesive for 60 seconds to secure.

* For a good adhesion, please wait 15-20 min before tugging on your drawers/cabinets.



Using the DRAWERLOCK

To unlock the latch, simply push in the two release buttons on the side and pull open the drawer/cabinet. Then close the cabinet/drawer and the DRAWERLOCK will automatically lock into place.
